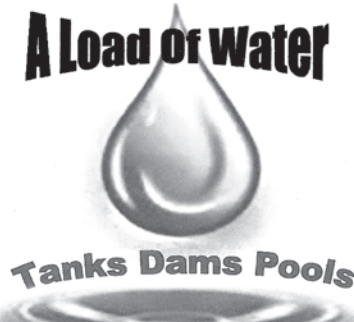

Going once, going twice...

The residents of the Fraser Coast and outlying areas are obviously sold, on having another horse sale and general auction. Following the success of the inaugural Horse Sale last year, the Fraser Coast Show Society is again lining up some of the regions best horses and chattels to go under the hammer.

"Last year was well attended and sales were high" said Martine Britton, Executive Officer of the Fraser Coast Show Society. "This year the community asked us to expand the sale to include a general auction and it is shaping up to be a big one with two tractors, a float and a slasher tentatively booked in."

Ms Britton suggests that anyone wishing to book in a horse or an item should do so as soon as possible as there will be cut offs if necessary to allow sufficient time for the general auction. Bookings and enquiries should be directed to the Show Office on 4123 5311.

The auction will be held on Sunday 18th October in the cattle yards and goat pavilion at the Maryborough Showgrounds. Entry for buyers and sellers is through Gate 5 and there will signage to direct people to the sale. A canteen will be available throughout

the day for hot food and refreshments. Gates open for registrations at 6am and buyers are reminded there is to be no bidding without a bidder's card. The sale commences promptly at 9.30am and promises to be a great family day out - everyone is welcome to come along and have a look and maybe take home a little extra.

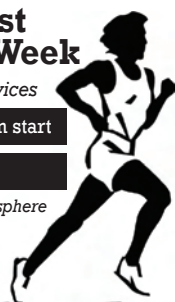
